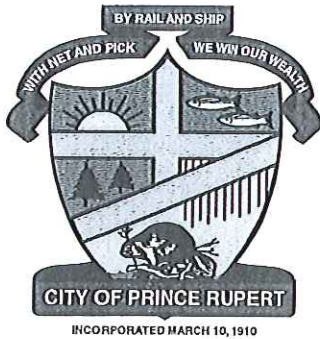
Once into construction, we found Bry Sand to be on time, providing arena slabs well within allowable variances. Warranty inspections passed without concern.
